### Producer

Having worked on the family estate all his life, his 3 menziones situated around the winery – Lazairasco, Santa Caterina and I Pari are exposed south-east and south-west taking full advantage of the sunshine and creating styles made in the traditional way that demonstrate the weight and concentration that Serralunga is famous for. This is not to say the wines are giants; Guido manages to pursue and extract a fragrance and precision in his wines that is quite extraordinary.

### Tasting Notes

An intense garnet red in color with ruby highlights and with aromas of very ripe berry and cherry fruit combined with floral and spicy notes. Powerful flavors with supple and ample tannins and a long finish and aftertaste. Its full body and significant structure make it an ideal match for meat, game, and cheese. Serve at a temperature of 17° centigrade (18° Fahrenheit).
