### Tasting Notes

Medium to full-bodied, superb fruit and spice aromas with an oaky note. Intense, full and yet delicate on the palate, the wine has a charming velvetiness. Very good ageing potential

### Viticulture

A 3.92 hectare parcel out of an overall surface area of 32 hectares for the Beaune Grèves appellation. The orientation is east/south east and the soil is clay/limestone but with a large amount of sandy gravel. The viticulture is done according to the Haute Valeur Environnementale (HVE) charter and harvesting is done by hand. The total Bouchard Père et Fils estate's configuration, extending as it does over 48 km from north to south with a mosaic of 450 different vineyards, protects the domaine from localised weather events such as hail, storms or frost. However, this does entail having to have teams on the ground throughout the vineyards. The multitude of vineyard parcels special care and care and attention all round year.
