Tasting Notes

With mineral geology at its core, and an average vine age of almost 15 years across the three vineyards, the chalk and yeast-complexed fruit of the 2019 Trouble with Dreams is both assured and composed as well as thrillingly precise; with drive, power, detail and finesse delivering a long, tapering finish. It displays all the qualities of fruit picked at peak possible maturity before persistent rains set in after 12th October that year.

Winemaking

50% Mount Harry Vineyard, East Sussex, planted 2006 chalk with clay loam, 55-80m above sea-level 30% Coldharbour Vineyard, West Sussex, planted 2005 chalk with clay and flints, 70-100m above sea level Storrington Priory Vineyard, West Sussex, planted 2006 on sandy loam over chalk and greensand, 50-60m above sea level Excellent yield due to no spring frosts and healthy flowering
