

## Tre Venti Nero d'Avola, Cantine Birgi



### Tasting Notes

The Nero d'Avola has an intense ruby red color. Its nose is rich with ripe dark fruits like blackberry and plum, along with hints of herbs, vanilla, cocoa, and leather. On the palate, it is full-bodied, with firm tannins and flavors of dark fruit, tobacco, and a touch of minerality. The finish is long, with a refreshing acidity and lingering notes of spices and dried fruit.

### Winemaking

Nero d'Avola thrives in the warm, sun-drenched climate of Marsala, producing bold wines with intense fruit flavors and balanced acidity. The volcanic soils add a unique minerality. Winemaking typically involves fermentation in stainless steel or oak, with some aging for added complexity. The variety is known for aging well, developing greater depth and texture over time.
