

Château Léoville-Barton, St Julien (2ème Cru Classé)



Tasting Notes

The opulence of this wine proves it is the fruit of a sun-blessed vintage, yet with none of the excesses associated with this. The power is certainly present but not domineering thanks to the lively freshness and complexity. There are also hints of sugar, toast, tar and spices. 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22,5% Merlot, 0,5 Cabernet Franc

Soil: Deep gravel on clay subsoil - Vine density: 9100 vinestocks per hectare - Average vine age: 38 years old
Drawing off into the barrels lot by lot. Ageing between 16 to 18 months in French oak barrels of which 60% are new
