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BURGUNDY 2023

VINTAGE REPORT

Years ending in a “3” don’t usually inspire confidence in Burgundy lovers. Think of 2003 — a year of blistering heat that left parched vines and overripe fruit. Or 2013 — the polar opposite, where rain and rot diluted much of the crop. But 2023 sits comfortably in the middle: a balanced and generous vintage.

The year began well — a little dry at first, but March rains arrived, and crucially, frost stayed away. This good fortune continued into flowering, where settled conditions led to record-breaking fruit set across the region.

June was notably warmer (3°C above average), while August brought intermittent rain followed by an unusual late-month heatwave. Early September rains threatened acidity levels, but cool nights and lingering warmth rebalanced the grapes, preserving freshness.

There were isolated outbreaks of mildew, particularly in Chablis, where **Domaine Louis Michel** saw yields as low as 30hl/ha in Grenouilles, Les Clos, and Montée de Tonnerre. Yet, mildew doesn’t necessarily impact quality — quite the opposite: smaller berries concentrate juice and acidity. Localised hail on May 1st further reduced yields in northern Chablis and Fourchaume.

As **Isabelle Raveneau** notes, “Climate change has helped us in Chablis — but the wines are not the same. The balance between acid and sugar is very different to what it was ten years ago.” Ripening degrades acidity faster now, and growers are adjusting. Guillaume is adding wires to protect Montée de Tonnerre from frost, and Cecile at **Maison Auvigue** is trialling leaf plucking above the fruit zone to slow ripening and reduce photosynthesis.

2023 is the largest Burgundy vintage on record, with 1.9 million hl produced — 26% above the 5-year average in the Côte d’Or, and Grand Crus up nearly 29%. Some growers skipped green harvesting, leading to excessive yields and diluted wines — styles that will lack aging potential. But the top producers, meticulous as always, delivered excellent results. Even at **Raveneau**, where they aim for 45hl/ha, they ended up with 70hl/ha — surprising, but controlled. Some neighbours, though, reached over 100hl/ha — **wines to avoid** in 2023.

CHABLIS

Stylistically, the 2023 wines are buoyant, with lifted fruit and firm mineral cores, already showing clear terroir expression. Tension and fierce acidity run through them — finesse is the hallmark of the whites.

As Isabelle notes, “*Vintages are now so different; producers have to work hard to create consistency.*”

In context: 2022 saw hardly any rain, 2024 had double the norm, and 2023 sat between the extremes. **Raveneau** even rented extra barrels for 2023 but has since returned them — a reminder that generous vintages are no longer guaranteed.

Producers are now questioning old wisdom, like Grand Crus’ south-facing amphitheatres. Cooler slopes are increasingly valued. It’s telling that Isabelle now finds many **Premier Crus** more interesting than Grand Crus — food for thought when comparing wines from riper vintages.

CÔTE DE NUITS

In 2023, concentration is up. Thicker skins counterbalanced the higher yields, and gentle rains kept acidity levels intact. **At Domaine Truchetet**, vineyard work focuses on mitigating climate change: higher stakes allow taller canopies to shade rows, easily spotted as you drive through Nuits-Saint-Georges. Reds were 100% de-stemmed this year — an earlier harvest meant stems weren’t ripe.

A standout addition for us this year is **Domaine des Lambrays**. Visiting in November was eye-opening. Some vines here are over 100 years old, adding immense depth and complexity. Since **Jacques Devauges** (ex-Domaine d’Arlot) took over in 2019, the estate has embraced biodynamics and parcel-by-parcel vinification, supported by a stunning, functional new winery. As Jacques says, “A good wine is good always, from the tank to the end.” We were especially struck by the **Richemone** — a wine of extraordinary expression and complexity.

2023 also marks our **second allocation from Thibault Liger-Belair** — wines that are pure poetry. The **Vosne-Romanée ‘Aux Réas’** overdelivers for its level, thanks to its sunny, south-facing exposure. Having walked his **Clos Vougeot** vineyards last June, we can better appreciate the **elastic tannins, buoyant fruit, and seamless savoury undertones** — the gravel soils lending early ripening and elegance. Where the Vougeot is layered and graceful, the **Richebourg** is bolder, fragrant, and herbal — a knockout wine.

CÔTE DE BEAUNE

Our visit to **Jacques Carillon** was, as always, filled with technical insights. Grapes rest 24 hours in a cold room before oak fermentation and a total of 18 months on lees (12 in barrel, 6 in tank). If only it were that simple to make wines of this quality! The **2023 whites are exceptional — taut, yet rounded, already showing strong terroir**. The **Bâtard-Montrachet** is a highlight: high-toned minerality, exotic fruits, flint core, sa-line finesse, and incredible length (19/20).

Jean-Baptiste at Domaine Michel Bouzereau, smiles all round — “Very nice,” he said of yields (60-65hl/ha). He’s surprised by the whites’ quality, which surpassed even their high harvest expectations.

In Pommard, once seen as rustic, **warmer vintages** have added ripeness and depth. **Domaine Lejeune** is a new addition for us — once known for heavy-handed whole bunch, now finding elegance under Louis de Belleruche. Cooler ferments, less extraction — **joyous lift and balance**. We can’t wait to introduce these wines in Ireland.

Bouchard Père & Fils kept yields in check (6 bunches per vine), meaning 2023 production matches 2022. Under **Artemis Holdings**, they’ll **hold back release until next year**, once the wines better reflect their potential. Winemaker **Frédéric Weber** called 2023’s flowering “perfect,” and sees the vintage as “a little more classic, with beautiful acidity.”

CÔTE CHALONNAISE

At **Domaine de la Folie**, less new oak has sharpened the whites’ natural fruit. The **Clos du Chaigne** and other northerly sites shine with elegance and freshness.

Our visit to Xavier at **Champs de Themis** in Bouzeron coincided with a snowstorm — but the wines were worth the effort, showing remarkable depth and purity.

At **Domaine Ragot**, renovations include a sleek amphora room. Nicolas is experimenting with **amphora-aged Grand Berge** and larger foudres for **Champs Pourot**, emphasizing reductive methods over SO2. Reds see alternating cool and warm ferments to preserve color and fruit — **constant innovation at every visit**.

DOMAINE FRANÇOIS RAVENEAU

In 1948 François Raveneau consolidated his vineyard holdings with his wife's (who was a Dauvissat) family parcels and started to build on the tiny plots. Today the 10 hectares domaine is run by his grandchildren – Isabelle and Maxime. Like their father's before them, Isabelle works in the cellar and Maxime in the vineyards. Most of the plots are under a hectare, only Montée de Tonnerre and Butteaux are larger. Activities in the vineyard are traditional, with heavy pruning in the winter to reduce yields. A high proportion of old vines explains some of the concentration in the bottle. In the winery it is the small 7-8 year old feuillettes that explain some of the creamy depth of these tremendous wines. The tiny quantities from this small domaine mean that the wines are sold on strict allocation.

DOMAINE LOUIS MICHEL & FILS

A family of winemakers since the 19th century the Michel family vineyards are planted on the first slopes to be farmed by Cistercian monks during the 11th century. The 25 hectares encapsulate 3 Grand Crus and 7 Premier Crus as well as Chablis and Petit Chablis terroir. Guillaume Michel runs the domaine, now 80% of the vines are farmed organically, he is strictly sustainable in the vineyards with the highest level of HVE certification.

DOMAINE THIBAUT LIGER-BELAIR

Thibault took over the vineyards of his family domaine in 2001. The family have been producing wine in the Cotes de Nuits since the 18th Century. Thibault's passion is the expression of terroir, but on this journey he became heavily invested in the impact of oak. Today, Thibault selects the trees in the forests to eventually house his wines during élevage. His focus in this interaction is to match the oak to the various soils in his vineyards. The various cuvees carry his passion and direction, displaying huge complexity and elegance. These are wines with soul.

DOMAINE DES PIERRES ROSES, MOULIN A VENT

Thibault has 13ha of vines in Moulin a Vent. He works regeneratively on this land. Like in Nuits-Saint-Georges he isolates each terroir within the appellation to make the most of its identity. The mulch below the vines creates latent heat warming the soils in this exposed site. 'Les Vieilles Vignes' is a blend of 9 parcels, east facing taking in the on-coming breezes. Each year a proportion of the grapes are whole bunch fermented. 'Champs de Cour' is on the south facing slope below the windmill, warmer soils and yellow granite drive perfumed, riper tones. These wines will benefit from time in bottle.

DOMAINE DES LAMBRAYS

We are proud to welcome Domaine des Lambrays to our portfolio. Revered and respected for their persevering pursuit of excellence. The estate itself hails back to the 1365 with the monks of the Citeaux. The domaine owns 99.6% of the esteemed Grand Cru Clos des Lambrays. Certified organic and since 2020 working with biodynamics the winemaking has since 2019 been managed by Jaques Devauges. He has overseen a complete renewal of the winery to enable parcel vinifications highlighting specific terroir expression within the vineyard holdings. Each of the 11 lots within the Clos des Lambrays is now vinified and aged separately. The allocations are tiny, this is an estate that embodies the finesse and complexity that define great Burgundy.

DOMAINE TRUCHETET

An exciting domaine nestled into the hamlet of Premeaux-Prissey in Nuits Saint Georges. Brother and sister Morgan and Julie Truchetet, along with Morgan's partner Pauline Genot took over the reins of their family domaine in 2019. The energy of this 6th generation of Truchetets is palpable. They do much of the work themselves, focussed very much on the soil and natural balance in the vineyard. The 6.5 ha of vines are in organic conversion and yield excellent wines that show great elegance and precision. They also make wines under their negociant label Morgan Truchetet, with grapes that they control from harvest date onwards and vinify to their exceptional standards.

DOMAINE GÉRARD SEGUIN

This estate dates back to the 1800's, it was Alexis Seguin who was one of the pioneers of grafting American rootstocks following the Phylloxera crisis of the 1880's. Gerard now manages the estate with his son Jerome, they have gradually been adding new parcels of vines over the years and have built up an estate of 6.25 hectares primarily in Gevrey-Chambertin. The vineyards are run sustainably with most of the cellar work, especially the bottling, performed in conjunction with the Biodynamic calendar.

DOMAINE BOUCHARD PÈRE ET FILS

As the largest vineyard owners in Burgundy, with 130 hectares of vines (including 12ha Grand Cru and 75 ha of Premier Cru), Bouchard Père et Fils are in a strong position to maximise the quality of their wines. In the vineyards the translation of terroir into glass is driven by a focus on biodiversity and soil health. This year we have focussed on the heart of their production, selecting wines from their vineyards that offer the best value in an increasingly speculative market.

DOMAINE HUBERT LAMY

The Lamy family have been working vines in Burgundy since 1640, but it wasn't till 1973 that Hubert Lamy created his own domaine on 8ha. Having studied winemaking and gathered experience from time working in other domaines, Oliver Lamy joined the family business in 1995. His approach is very focused on the vineyard and thanks to the limestone influence here, Chardonnay dominates at 80% of the plantings. Currently there are 18.5ha of vines over 20 appellations producing 110,000 bottles. He prefers to use oak in the form of the larger demi-muids, used to add texture rather than influence flavour.

DOMAINE COMTE ARMAND

A 9ha domaine Comte Armand produces the esteemed monopoly Clos des Epeneaux, along with a range of wines from plots located in Volnay and Auxey-Duresses. The Clos des Epeneaux is a magnificent parcel of five hectares acquired by Nicolas Marey at the end of the 18th century. The vineyards are certified organic and cultivated biodynamically. Since Paul Zinetti took over the winemaking in 2014 the wines have evolved further. In the words of Jasper Morris MW they have taken on a more enhanced, refined and pure style.' All grapes are de-stemmed with a longer time resting on the skins than many. Paul said from the outset that he wanted to make a less tannic wine in the Clos, and one which is more about aromatic length.

DOMAINE LEJEUNE

Founded in 1783 by Maxime Lejeune, at the time a grand estate of over 50ha, gradually eroded by the divisive inheritance laws to the 8.7ha that it stands at today. Harriet has excellent memories of the domaine from early in her wine career through a visit with the Burgundy Wine Board. The quality of the fruit and purity helped by whole bunch stood out. Under new ownership since 2023, new winemaker Louis de Belleruche is eager to capitalise on the outstanding vineyards and oldervines. With 8 years experience at Clos des Lambrays his style is more focussed on perfume and purity, illustrated in the wines of 2023 with lower proportions of whole bunch and gentler pressings. In the vineyards they are working hard to rebalance the older vines. Moving to cane renewal rather than trunk pruning and controlling buds to provide small grapes and lower yields. With Burgundy prices ever increasing, the price to quality ratio on this Pommard domaine is what caught our eye.

DOMAINE JACQUES CARILLON

The Carillon family have been making wines in Puligny-Montrachet since the 16th Century. Jacques and Sylvia set up their own domaine in 2010 following 30 years working on his father's estate. Domaine Jacques Carillon comprises 5.25ha, all the wines are made from their own grapes grown in a sustainable way using Integrated Pest Management and the avoidance of herbicides. The wines are made to reflect the limestone led terroir with only 15-20% new barrels allowing that sanguine minerality to explode from the glass after some time in bottle.

DOMAINE RAGOT

Nicolas Ragot has run his family Domaine of 9.5ha since 2008. The Domaine underwent a complete renovation in 2003 when Nicolas and his father Jean Paul upgraded the cellar. Nicolas is heavily involved in sustainability, both on his estate and in the region of Givry. Work in the vineyards avoids the use of herbicides, beneficial crops act as a natural barrier against weeds and effective tool in water regulation to the vines. This approach is not limited to the vineyards; their cellar is 100% off grid.

LES CHAMPS DE THEMIS

Organically farmed with minimal sulphur useage, they offer great value and incredible depth from such young domaine. As with most of Burgundy today, allocations are small with this domaine. Originally from Nuits-Saint-George, Xavier decided to move south to start his own project. He rents the land that is farmed organically in the vineyards around Bouzeron. Bouzeron in the Côte Chalonnaise is the only commune to grow 'golden' Aligote. All the vines are mature with some vines over 80 years old, the concentration and definition from the older vines gives huge complexity to the wines. What impressed Harriet about the wines, was the careful use of oak, elevating the fruit aromas and adding depth to the palate of each wine. Xavier works closely with the Chassin tonnellerie, ensuring that each plot has the perfect elevage.
